She writes:

Thankfully we have managed to keep most of the schools open in Iceland, although within limits. Some children go every second day for 2 hours to school, others get to stay every morning and of course there are many children that can not attend school at all. There is little variety because every class has to stay with the class teacher and meet no one else. Therefore, I asked music teachers to make casual recordings to send to children everyday, one song is broadcasted every day in a TV show for children that is called "Education during Covid". These examples are spontaneous recordings with Iphone from the classroom for the children at home inviting them to join the songs.

> The first song is called: HRESSTU ÞIG VIÐ and means: Cheer up and freshen up your joints.

> The second song is called: MYNDIN HENNAR LÍSU "Lisa's painting : "Yellow for sun, green for life and grey for the ones who force men to war...the earth is for everyone!

> The third VIKIVAKI says: "Spring comes and the world gets warmer, my love"

> The fourth is about Michel von Lönneberga (Astrid Lindgren.)
